

PROGRAM GUIDANCE:

Virtual Army Website

ARNG education's latest information, updates, and portal. You can fill out your Federal TA application and submit it online. You can also submit other online applications such as request for degree plans, or request Student Guide to Success and eDiscover services.

ARNG State Education Service Office

Your state office is the Soldiers' local point of contact regarding education benefit information. This is the point of contact and approving authority for Federal Tuition Assistance applications. They also manage testing centers for the various exams, and facilitate GI Bill and student loan repayment program eligibility.

ARNG Education Support Center (ESC)

The Army National Guard Education Support Center (ARNG ESC) is the national level agency for education benefits for soldiers of the Army National Guard, their dependents, and civilian employees of the Guard. The ESC supports the state education offices and has subject matter experts who can help you maximize your education benefits. Services are available 12 hours daily, M-F, from 6am to 6pm CST. Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA)

Organization that receives applications, approves, and makes payments of GI Bill benefits. Regional DVA offices work with college Veterans Affairs representatives (usually within registrars/admissions departments) for paperwork certification. Regional DVA offices also work with State officials for apprenticeships and OJT paperwork.

Member's Unit/Recruiters

Your ARNG unit and/or local recruiter are your point of contact for gaining eligibility for the ARNG Kicker, and HPLR and SLRP benefits. Each of these programs have specific requirements and/or service commitment for eligibility.



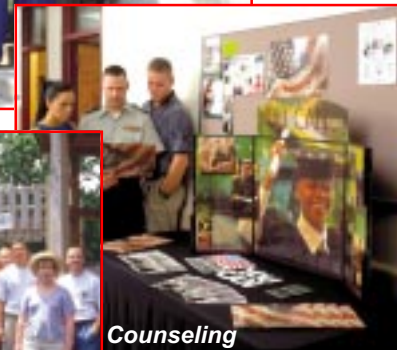
